I am Canan, from Kurdistan. I worked as a volunteer in a kindergarten in Vienna for ten months. That was different from standard kindergartens. It was inspired by forest schools and aimed to allow children to complete their pedagogical development freely in nature, without physical boundaries. Working in such a school is very interesting for me. In addition to experiencing all the changes in nature with the seasons, I observe how creative and healthy children can be in nature.





In Vienna, I was staying in an apartment quite close to the city center, and it would have been fine if it wasn't. Transportation in Vienna is quite comfortable and easy. I shared the apartment with two wonderful women. We came from three different countries and cultures, but there was a great harmony between us.
