My everyday tasks were playing with the kids, supporting the teacher, and helping with lunch, but I was always happy when I had the possibility to escape these routines and bring some of my ideas to my project.

Mirjam and me did an Austria Project with the kids from our groups. We cooked and baked traditional food, crafted a big "Austria-Scenery", taught them German words and danced to traditional music.

My favorite project was the wall in the playground, that me and the other volunteers painted. The Kids love it, it was so much fun to do that, and it is so nice to know, that there is something that I created, that will stay there even when I have left.





Apart from work I had many opportunities to explore Portugal and its incredibly various nature. There is so much to see and I loved travelling the country and getting to see so many new places.

At the on-arrival training, I met a guy who volunteers on Madeira and in January me and my friends visited him there. The island is one of the most beautiful places that I have ever seen, I still can't believe that I have really been there and that it was not just a dream.

In April, me and my two best friends here rented a van and went on a roadtrip from Lisbon to the Algarve and this was such an amazing experience too! Portugal has so much to offer, I am so grateful that I had the opportunity to live in such an amazing country!
